#### 2023 Board of Directors Elections

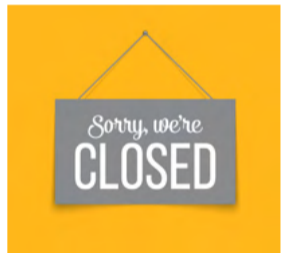
