## IMPORTANT UPDATE: CHANGES TO OUR TRUTH IN SAVINGS DISCLOSURES



Effective November 15, 2024, we are adding the following under Membership in our TIS disclosures:

If you reduce the share balance below the Par Value of One Share and do not increase the balance to at least the Par Value of One Share within 3 months of the reduction, you may be terminated from membership.

This change affects membership requirements:

- Members must maintain a minimum balance equal to \$5.00 in Regular Share accounts.
- If your balance falls below this amount, you'll have a 3-month period to restore it.
- Failure to meet this requirement may result in membership termination.
